

Locating “Streaming” Media (videos and sound recordings)

On the web, go to: www.scl.utah.edu
[or, click on address on Media List page on my site]

Under Audio-Visual Resources click on “Media Streaming”

Under “Authentication” [on the upper left] type your University ID and password, [same as you would to get your email or to register] click “login”

At “Search website” [on upper right] type McDannell [my name]

You should see the list of all the videos I am using in my classes

Find the video or music that you want. The list is alphabetical by title, so scroll until you get what you want

Click on the icon for the size you want to see.

This will pull up “QuickTime”. If the movie is not on your screen click the “Media Streaming” tab again. This will bring it up, although it might take some time to load.

Trouble Shooting

You cannot get to the site through the general Library page. You need to use the address: www.scl.utah.edu

If the list comes up but the videos say “Restricted” you haven’t logged in and “authenticated.” The site needs to know you are a student at the U.

Make sure you have the most recent version of QuickTime. You can download it for free at <http://www.apple.com/quicktime/download/>
